




GS1 Kenya is a Member Organization affiliated to GS1 Global present in over 115 countries. GS1 Kenya was formed in 2006 succeeding EAN Kenya which had been in existence since 1998. We enable organizations of all types and sizes to identify, capture and share information seamlessly.

At GS1 Kenya our goal is to support GS1 standards' adoption and use across all industries to transform the business ecosystem by changing manufacturer's, retailer's and consumer's experience to the best.



WHAT WE DO

The GS1 System is an integrated suite of global standards that provides for accurate identification and communication of information regarding products, assets, services, locations, relationships and documents based on the concepts of Identify, Capture and Share.



Over 1.5 million users across 145 countries and more than 25 industry sectors have adopted the GS1 System. It is recognized by organizations such as the International Organization for Standardization (ISO), the American National Standards Institute (ANSI), World Health Organization (WHO) and the European Committee for Standardization (CEN).



Using GS1 identification numbers, companies around the world are able to uniquely identify physical items like trade items, assets, logistic units, shipments, physical locations and documents, as well as logical items like corporations or a service relationship between provider and recipient.

GS1 Liner Barcodes

Global data and application standards for barcodes that use the globally recognized GS1 Identification Keys to automatically identify things such as trade items, locations, logistic units, and assets. These are identified using Global Trade Item Number (GTIN), Global Location Number (GLN), Serial Shipping Container Code (SSCC) and Global Returnable Asser Identifier (GRAI)





GS1 Two-dimensional Barcode (2-D barcodes)

The GS1 2D barcodes helps connect myriad sources of data directly to the consumer by ensuring cost effective traceability for every product across the supply chain. We use tools such as GS1 Data matrix and GS1 QR Codes

Barcode Verification: is a barcode quality check that allows our customers to scan their products with a lot of ease



Verified by **GS1-** Hakikisha Bidhaa: Is a solution where by identification technique capturing products' GTINs are captured with specific attributes like brand name, product description, product image, net content and country of sale. It can help the organizations to answer the question, is this the product I think it is?





Fixed Asset Management Solutions:

It encompasses physical asset tags and fixed assets management solutions for track and trace.

Warehouse Management Solutions: we offer solution standards that improve efficiency, safety and visibility to warehouse inventories.



Healthcare: As a patient you are entitled to the best care. The use of our GS1 standards in healthcare increases patient safety, drives supply chain efficiencies and improves the traceability of medicines and medical devices.





Fresh Produce: We walk the journey with our Fresh Produce members in implementing traceability in fresh fruit & vegetable supply chains using the GS1 standards for identification, data capture, data sharing & the GS1 Global Traceability Standard.

Transport & Logistics: As a manufacturer, retailer or logistics service provider, you need to know exactly where your shipments of goods are at any time, where they have come from, and when and where they are due to arrive. The use of GS1 standards gives you accurate up-to-date information about all these matters so that you can make good decisions for your business.



Data Management

GS1 Data Quality aims to support and drive improved data quality throughout the supply chain (B2B2C). Data are of high quality if they are fit for their intended uses in operations, decision making, and planning. GS1's Data Quality Framework (DQF), an industry-sponsored, unified approach to achieving sustainable data quality and is a key resource of best practices for data quality management.





GS1 GDSN®

The Global Data Synchronization Network $^{\text{TM}}$ (GDSN $^{\text{TM}}$) is an automated, global standards-based platform that enables secure and continuous data synchronization, allowing all partners to have consistent item data in their systems at the same time
